Once more the challenges for education and educators are imposed.</p> <p>Education faces the duty to provide equal access to learning opportunities for all students, regardless of their individual differences, abilities, or backgrounds. Education focuses on the creation of an environment for every student. Recognition of all students' value, support and preparation for real life are some of the main principals included in such an environment.</p> <p>We realize that such an education contrasts with traditional models, which have often excluded students with disabilities or other challenges, as migration or vulnerable social groups.</p> <p>The course, rooted in the 4th Goal of S.D., focuses on inclusion and integration and refers to the process of integrating these students social, cultural and economic environment of the host country.</p> <p>The course is designed to provide teachers with sustainable tools for understanding and accepting</p>

<p><b>Objectives, skills&amp; competencies</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To help newcomers have the same access to essential services, such as education, healthcare, housing, and employment, as native citizens by providing to them opportunities to learn the local language.</li> <li>2. To promote cultural exchange and respect for the traditions, languages, and identities of immigrant populations, enriching the broader society. They learn to explore different cultures, historical periods, social circumstances, the importance of freedom in expression of ideas.</li> <li>3. To develop essential relationship between immigrants and local societies.</li> <li>4. To help all the students develop empathy, tolerance, and understanding. They learn to appreciate diversity and form positive relationships with people who are different from themselves.</li> <li>5. To establish higher expectations and motivation for students with disabilities by collaborating learning. Students who grow up learning and working together tend to support policies and practices that promote equality and social cohesion</li> <li>6. To encourage innovation in teaching and learning.</li> <li>7. To improve health and well – being.</li> <li>8.
